### **Executive Director's Report:**

- Edgar E. Baker Community Service Award needs 3-5 board members to serve on the committee to pick this year's winner. Janet, Cherese, and Michael volunteered to head up the committee.
- United Lutheran Seminary held a meeting on possible development on the campus on September 24<sup>th</sup> for the Board of EMAN and Mt. Airy BID. We were asked by members of the community to meet with Councilwoman Cindy Bass prior to any scheduled public meeting with ULS.
- We had multiple members of the community reach out regarding the proposed development at the current site of the Trolley Car Diner.
  - The project will be mixed-use
  - Blake Development will be the developer
  - The sale of the property is slated for next year
  - EMAN will reach out to the future developer about a community meeting

- Mt. Airy2025 collaborate includes WMAN, EMAN and Mt. Airy CDC. The collaborate has decided to switch
  gears and host quarterly invents instead of an annual submit to provide more touch points, and to allow for a
  deep dive into each topic.
- Mt. Airy Schools Coalition is planning a realtors tour for October 25<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>.
- A letter was sent out to Councilwoman Bass from EMAN regarding the nuisance business on Chew Avenue, which was receiving beer deliveries during school dismissal.

**Zoning:** The committee withdrew its proposal around Zoning Committee having an independent vote in some cases. The zoning committee has a meeting on September 23<sup>rd</sup> for 80 E. Sharpnack Street regarding a variance for the increase from 4 to 6 homes to be built on the site, and on October 1<sup>st</sup> on 19 E. Montana Street to add 6 additional children to her daycare center. The Committee began implanting the following measures at both meetings with great success:
